ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

Name of Corporation: Minnesota Youth Intervention Programs Association

We, the undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 317 Minnesota Statutes, known as the Minnesota Nonprofit Corporation Act, do hereby associate ourselves together as a body corporate and adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

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The name of this corporation shall be the Minnesota Youth Intervention Programs Association (YIPA).

ARTICLE II

The purposes of this corporation shall be exclusively for charitable, and educational purposes, namely:

- A. To provide an information exchange process for programs and individuals interested and involved in youth intervention programs within the State of Minnesota.
- B. To facilitate the information exchange and understanding between youth intervention programs and the public and private sectors.
- C. To provide a sound membership organization for youth intervention programs personnel.
- D. To provide support and assistance to youth intervention programs throughout the State of Minnesota in establishing, maintaining, and/or improving the quality of their services.
- E. To do all acts and things and carry on and conduct all other activities necessary, suitable, convenient, useful or expedient, in connection with or incidental to accomplish any of the purposes of this Article to the fullest extent permitted by the laws of the State of Minnesota, in carry—

 Ing out the above mentioned Sections.

- F. It may solicit and receive property of whatsoever nature or any interest therein by gift, transfer, devise, bequest, or otherwise; and it may invest and reinvest, hold manage, administer, expend, apply, and in every manner and means to deal in and with all such property subject to such terms, conditions, or limitations, if any, which are not violative of the purposes of the corporation, as may be experssed in any such gift, transfer, devise, or bequest. It may purchase, hold, sell, convey, mortgage, and in every manner and means deal in and with any property, real or personal. It may do all else authorized by the laws of the State of Minnesota for non-profit corporations not inconsistent with Section 501(c) (3) of Internal Revenue Code and as it may be hereafter amended with respect to qualifications of tax exempt corporations of the character of this corporation.
- G. No member, director, or officer of the corporation or other private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on liquidation, dissolution, or winding up of the corporation; and the corporation itself shall not in any way, directly or indirectly, particiapte or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office, by publishing or distributing statements or otherwise.

ARTICLE III

The corporation shall not afford pecuniary gain to its members, incidentally or otherwise.

ARTICLE IV

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V

The location, by city, town, or other community, of the registered office of this corporation in this state is St. Paul, Minnesota.

ARTICLE X

Neither members nor Director of the corporation shall have any personal liability for corporate obligations.

ARTICLE XI

The corporation shall have no capital stock.

ARTICLE XII

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c) (3) Internal Revenue Code, as amended; (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under 170(c) (2) Internal Revenue Code, as amended; or (c) by any future amendments to the Internal Revenue Code relating to either provision.

ARTICLE XIII

No officer or Director of the corporation shall make or attempt to make any loan to any officer, Director, or employee of the corporation out of the funds and/or assets or the corporation.

ARTICLE XIV

Upon the liquidation or dissolution of the corporation, it's assets shall be disposed of exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner as shall be, or to such organizations whose purposes shall be, in furtherance of the exempt purposes of organizations set forth in Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law). Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court exclusively for such purposes.
